

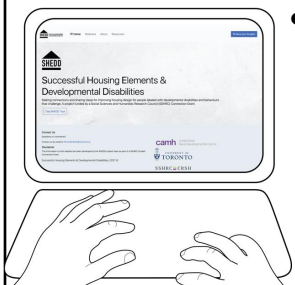
Knowledge Mobilization of Successful Housing Elements and Developmental Disabilities

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- Objectives**
- To disseminate & mobilize the SHEDD research & tool to build capacity for person-directed housing design for behaviours that challenge
 - To identify future multidisciplinary research collaborations to further develop and improve the SHEDD tool

- Methods**
- 4 webinars with tool developers, developmental service agencies, self-advocates, & caregivers
 - Website & social media communication



- Results**
- 329 webinar attendees, mostly developmental service providers and families
 - Webinar topics include SHEDD tool development, experiences from group homes & families, and person-directed planning

- Key Considerations**
- Include construction materials & details
 - Address language related to institutionalization
 - Explore funding affordability & policies
 - Highlight importance of social environments for creating a home
